

**Minutes for State Board for Career and Technical Education

Sonia Meehl requested that Levi Bachmeier report his opinions as a new member of the proposed funding model. Levi Bachmeier gave brief history of his duties with Governor's Office and his perspective of the policy.

Review Adjusted Funding Level Impact

Members reviewed the formula and it was felt that the local administration dollars need to be broken out to reflect the operation (overhead) cost and the administration FTE cost. There was also discussion on virtual definition and perhaps referring to it as hybrid as there needs to be hands-on components included. It was expressed that virtual has a different meaning pre-covid to post-covid. Committee needs to keep in mind that six principals and that output is our focus.

Discussion was held on the different tier and incentive dollars and how they were selected. It is felt that the committee needs to put the dollars where we want behavioral results and the some of the dollars are local responsibility. It was expressed that consideration should be only having two tiers – comprehensive high school and center, increase quality indicator levels and adjust access incentives.
