Wayde Sick reminded those present that this is an open meeting.

Subcommittee Timeline: Wayde Sick reviewed the timeline that the subcommittee had developed at the last meeting. There were no objections.

Josh Johnson asked that we move to the funding tier agenda item due to time restrictions of this meeting.

Wayde Sick reviewed the tiered funding model that was distributed and referenced the differences in each tier. We then discussed how these requirements would align to the six principles. It was felt that class size, access to courses and participation needs to be included in the requirements.

Wayde Sick reported on how the Idaho and Utah funding models operate which include dollars based on the program area and per pupil payments with incentives.

Wayde Sick then displayed a tiered option that CTE staff had devised after the last meeting. This option would consist of two sets of tiers, one based on the provider or format of the program and the other would be based on the quality of the program. Discussion was held on different variables to use such as number of students, number of programs offered and number of schools served.

The next subcommittee meeting will be in early January 2024.
