How to Sign In and Use RUReady.ND.gov

If you attend a private, tribal, non-public school or are a homeschool student, follow the instructions below to create your RUReady.ND.gov account.

How to create your RUReady.ND.gov account (first time users)

- 1. Go to RUReady.ND.gov.
- 2. Click Create an Account.
- 3. Select the role that best describes you from the **Who are you?** dropdown.
- 4. Enter your name and date of birth.
- 5. Select your school from the Your school, workforce center, or program dropdown.
- 6. Enter your email address (or one can be created for you based on your Username.)
- 7. Create your **Username** and **Password**.
- 8. Check the box if you agree to the privacy policy and terms of the site, then click Submit.

How to access your RUReady.ND.gov account (returning users)

- 1. Go to RUReady.ND.gov
- 2. Enter your Username and Password under Sign In.
- 3. Click the Sign In button.
