





How to Sign In and Use RUReadyND

You already have a RUReadyND account, all you need to do is sign in!

| 1 | <p>Go to your school's PowerSchool Sign In page and log in to your own PowerSchool student account.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Do not use a parent or guardian's login, only your student login will work. |  |
| 2 | <p>Once you are signed into PowerSchool, click on the Applications icon  on the main screen. This will take you to the ND Education Portal.</p> |  |
