QUALIFICATIONS:

- A. Complete an **application form**.
 - a. Request application from our website above (preferred method).
- B. Be a minimum of **18** years of age. Provide a copy of your **Birth Certificate**.
- C. Provide proof of successful completion of one full credit of high school **algebra** with a passing grade or one post high school algebra course with a passing grade.
- D. Be a high school graduate or have a GED. **Provide transcripts** for high school (or GED) and/or college. Applicants must have graduated from high school at time of selection and indenture, but can be close to graduating when applying.
- E. Submit a DD-214 to verify military training and/or experience if a veteran wishing to receive consideration for such training/experience.
- F. Possess and maintain a valid **driver's license**. A copy of your driver's license must be sent with your application.
- G. Prior to being indentured, applicants selected from the pool of interviewed applicants will be required to take a drug test set up and paid for by the JATC.

NOTE: The announcement is for the purpose of establishing a list of qualified applicants so apprentices can be selected according to qualifications alone.
